5. What reason does Paul give in Vs. 3 for engaging in prayer?
6. What does Vs. 4 tell us about God's desire towards the lost? How can you respond in light of this information?

7. What is a mediator and what role would such a person play? Why do we need a mediator between us and God?
  
8. Why / how is Jesus uniquely qualified to act as a mediator between God and man?
  
9. What are the implications of the Apostle saying that Jesus is the one and only mediator between God and Man?
  
10. How does 1 Timothy 2:5 differ from the teachings of Roman Catholicism?
  
11. What are the three callings that the Apostle referred to in Vs. 7?
  
12. How does Paul's role as a teacher to the Gentiles inform the mission of the church today?
